



Direct Support Professional (DSP)

Direct Support Professional positions provide supervision, training and care for Individuals with Intellectual Disabilities in our Residential Programs of Intermediate Care Facilities, Community Training Homes and Supervised Living Program.

This includes personal care, self-help skills, transportation needs, maintaining a safe, clean living environment, cooking and dining assistance, and the overall health, safety and accountability of individuals we support. Employees must be able to communicate well and document daily in electronic record management system.

Requirements include a High School Diploma or equivalent, at least 18 years of age, valid SC Driver's License with a good driving record and ability to pass all required training classes and background checks.
